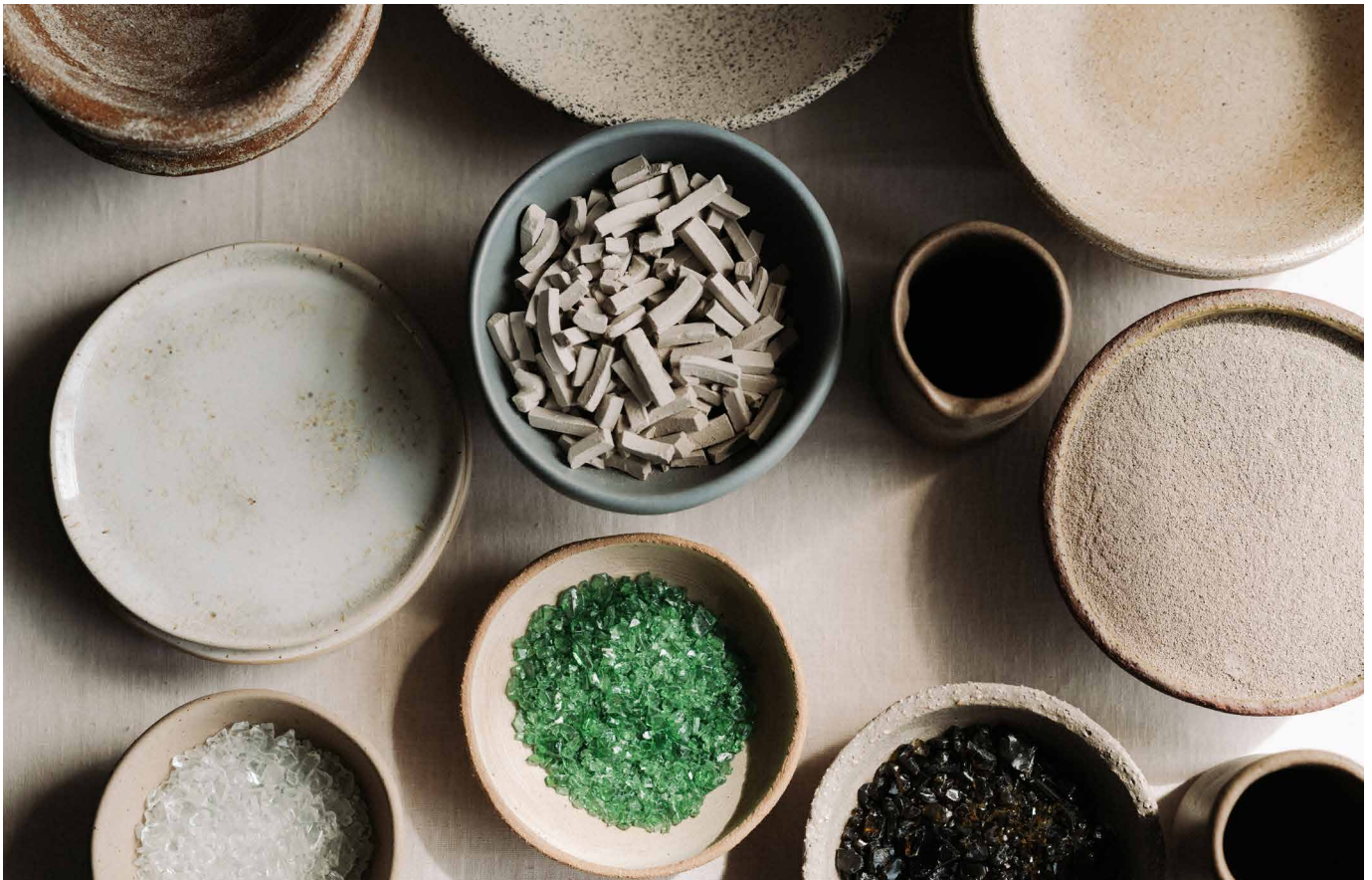


OUR PHILOSOPHY

Earth and water, this is how it all began. The earth is live-giving and when it is worked in any form with the hands, it is timelessly reborn in another shape. In our case, by the power of fire and air.

Each POEMI item and collection tells a story. We are inspired by things, experiences, and emotions from childhood. The plaster on the walls of the house, the passing of seasons which puts its mark on all and everything, the table with the three-legged chairs we used to eat at, the wooden tray where the bread was kneaded.

Having such a source of inspiration, our purpose is to create shapes, textures, and glazes that inspire both chefs who want to emphasize their dishes as well as people who wish to share the joy of a meal with family and friends.





The production process is complex and lasts for about four weeks, needing all our attention and care. After being manually made, the items are left to dry, until they are ready to be placed into the kiln. Next, the bisque firing follows, in special electrical kilns, at temperatures between 950 and 1000 degrees Celsius. A single firing cycle lasts for approximately 48 hours.

After the bisque firing, the items are glazed and a second firing cycle follows, at temperatures that vary between 1200 and 1280 degrees Celsius.

POEMI has a commitment to quality, aesthetics and particularly, to sustainability. In an effort to minimize waste, we recycle all the leftover stoneware during the production process and we repurpose it to make new pieces and glazes.

In order to create unique and stunning textures, we integrate another reclaimed element to some of our glazes, which is the wood ash, that we collect from our community. The color of this organic glaze is unique and might change from time to time, due to its reclaimed components.

 ZeRaw tag, derived from "zero" (zero waste) and "raw" (the texture of the glaze with wood ash), highlights the products that feature this unique reclaimed glaze. ZeRaw embodies our sustainable practices, transforming waste into beautiful, ever-evolving pieces.

MEET THE CREATORS

We are Alexandra and Florin, two young people who embarked on a remarkable journey into the world of ceramics driven by our love for craftsmanship and beauty. Back in 2016, with no prior experience in pottery, we commenced a self-taught adventure that has transformed our lives and ignited a passion within us that continues to burn bright.

We learned all by ourselves for two years, we honed our skills, pushing ourselves to unravel the mysteries of ceramics. With each clay-soaked day, we deepened our understanding of this exquisite art form. We learned to blend creativity with functionality and durability, transforming raw materials into timeless pieces that captivate the eye and enchant the senses.

Over the past years, we have had the privilege of designing numerous custom tableware projects for both local and international restaurants. We have embraced the opportunity to educate consumers about the importance of choosing sustainable, simple, and durable ceramics for their homes.

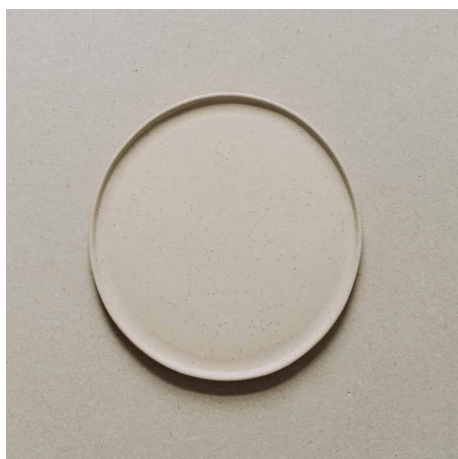
The beige stoneware brings a sense of warmth and richness to the table, while the matte white glaze adds a touch of modernity and refinement.

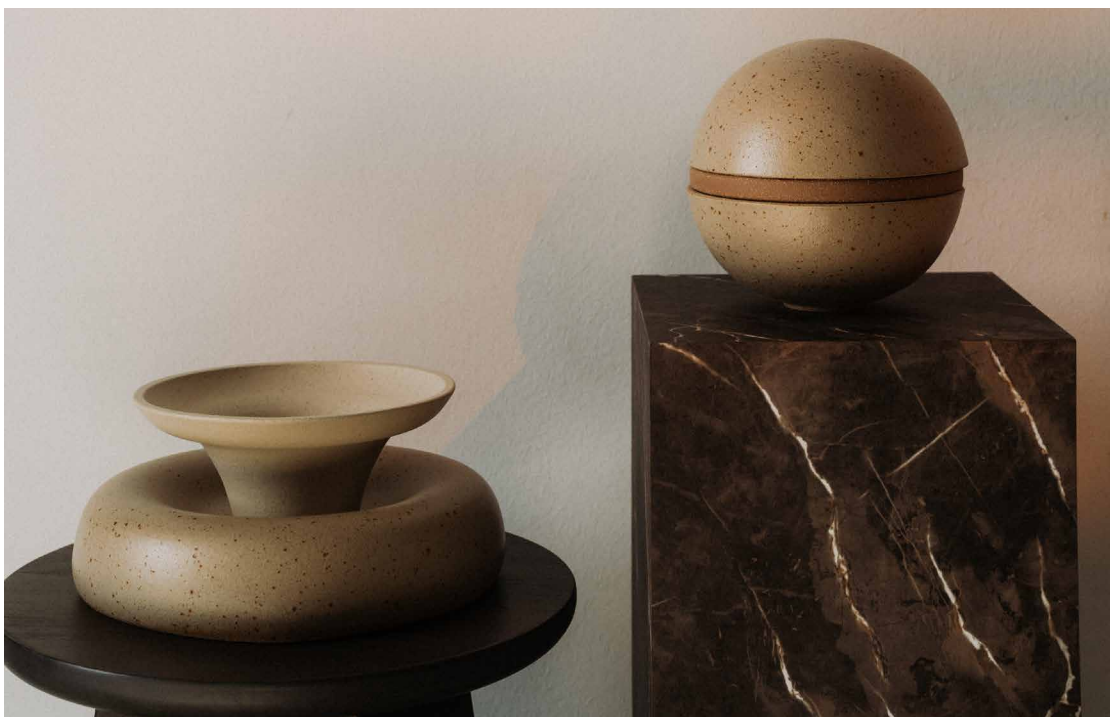
AARDE

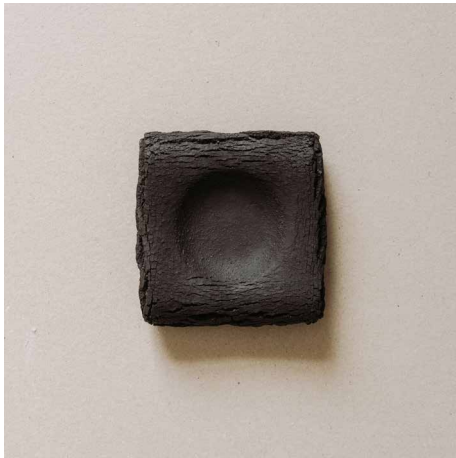
Aarde • Afrikaans (n.) earth, ground, soil with brownish effects.

Each piece is designed to complement and frame culinary creations, offering chefs a versatile and expressive canvas for their artistry.

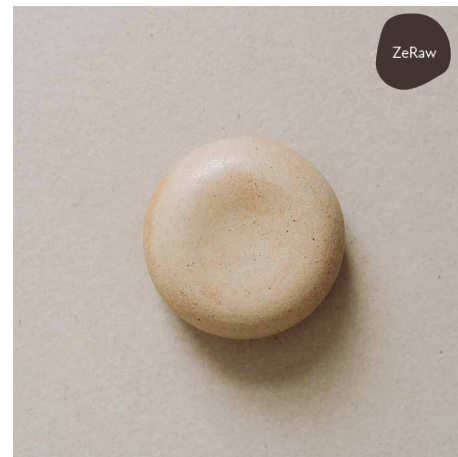

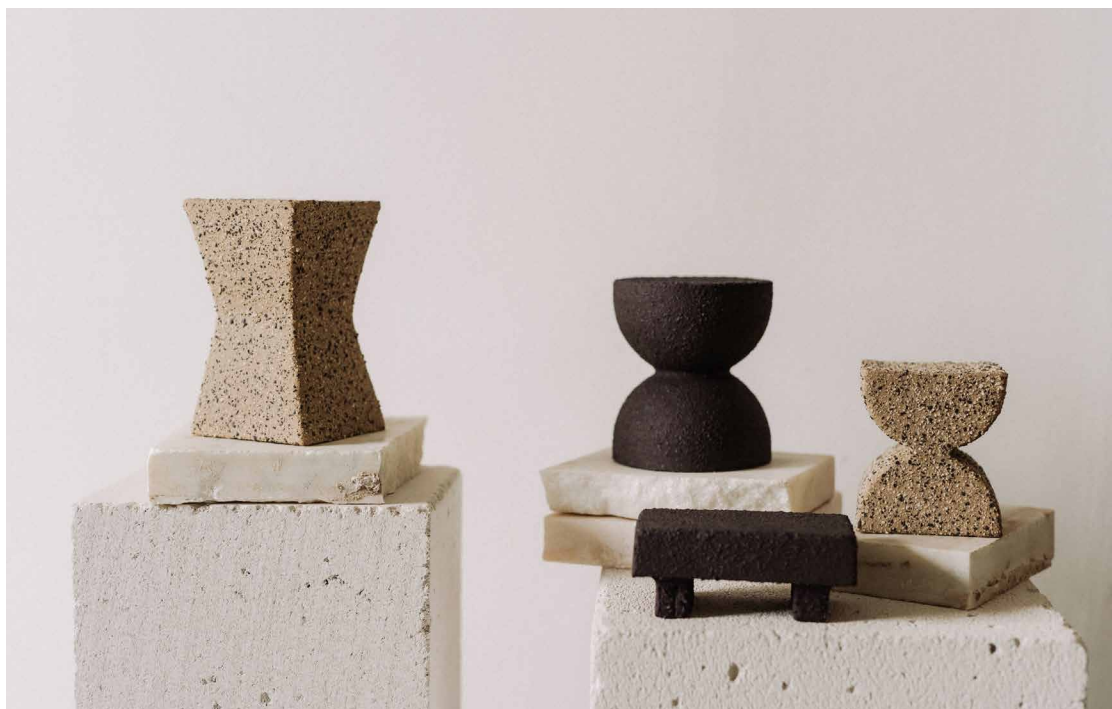
ORIGEN

As the name itself suggests, for this collection we went back to our origins, to the very point where everything began. The collection is a testament to the enduring beauty of tradition, thoughtfully reimagined for the modern age.

Origen is inspired by the works of visionary Constantin Brancusi (such as: the Endless Column, the Table of Silence, the Stool, the Cup), and by the traditional Romanian objects from our childhood (such as: the small three-legged table, the bench, the Romanian traditional shingle, the wooden bucket, the honeycomb).

Not only a visual delight, but also a tactile experience, each piece is meticulously handcrafted from terrazzo stoneware, infusing a sense of warmth and authenticity into every object.

Boasting a dual functionality, each piece can serve as both a decorative object and an exquisite addition to fine dining experiences, ideal for presenting amuse-bouche in upscale restaurants.
